General Information

1. When and where is this year's festival happening?

The 2026 Robbinsville Township Community Festival will be on Saturday, June 13 (rain date: June 14), from 2 to 9:30 p.m. It will take place at Robbinsville Community Park, located at 15 West Manor Way, Robbinsville.

2. Is there an admission fee to attend?

No. The Community Festival is free to attend. Only the food trucks will charge you.

3. Who organizes the community festival?

The Township of Robbinsville hosts this event with the Recreation Division overseeing all preparations.

4. Is there a theme for this year's festival?

Yes! This year, the festival will celebrate the 250th anniversary of the nation's independence.

5. What is the history or purpose of the community festival?

Starting as a Country Fair and Craft Show in 1981, the festival now celebrates our lively community each year with music, food, and laughter! Families and friends walk through bustling booths, enjoy live performances, and indulge in tasty treats, all while celebrating local talent. With no entrance fee (except for food), it's a great chance to make special memories and enjoy each other's company without spending a dime!

6. Who can attend — is it open to non-residents?

The Robbinsville community festival welcomes everyone!

7. Will there be an opening or closing ceremony?

We will start the event with the national anthem at 2 p.m. and end it with a spectacular fireworks display at 9 p.m.

Activities & Entertainment

8. Can residents volunteer to help with activities or setup?

The Robbinsville Recreation Division works hard—so you don't have to—to organize this event for our residents to enjoy with their families and friends. If there is a need in any area, we welcome your help. Just email us at rec@robbinsville.net.

9. What kinds of activities or entertainment will be offered?

The event will feature inflatables for children of all ages, including a rock-climbing wall, a trackless train, laser tag, pony rides, numerous giveaways from over 100 exhibitors, food trucks, Independence Day celebrations, and much more!

10. Will there be live music, shows, or performances?

Of course! The festivities include a DJ from 2 to 5 p.m. and live performances until 9 p.m.

11. Are there activities for children and families?

The whole family, including your pet, will enjoy the event's activities.

12. Is there a schedule of events we can view in advance?

2 p.m.: National Anthem and Independence Day celebrations

2:15 p.m.: Amusements, Prize Alley & Non-Profit vendor exhibits, Food Trucks, etc.

6 p.m.: Live band

7 p.m.: Featured music band

9 p.m.: Fireworks

We're still preparing for this fantastic day. Expect even more!

13. Will there be contests, raffles, or games to join?

We will likely hold our annual chocolate-eating contest. Winners take home a *David Bradley* chocolate basket!

Exhibitors & Food

10. What types of food and drinks will be available?

The township is organizing a variety of food and dessert trucks. A list will be published very soon! The festival will also feature an open beer and wine tent, sponsored and run by Robbinsville Meals on Wheels, to raise funds for this organization.

11. Will there be local vendors, artists, or businesses at the festival?

Selling products other than those from approved food trucks is prohibited by Ordinance. However, we invite all local businesses to participate in the exhibit areas, whether for-profit or non-profit.

12. Can I apply to be an exhibitor? If so, how?

Certainly! Please visit the event's website [here](#) and submit your application. The form is different for non-profit organizations and for-profit exhibitors. Please ensure that you complete the correct form.

13. Can local nonprofits or community groups host information tables?

Absolutely! We'd love for you to showcase your non-profit organization. Please fill out the form on the event's website, and we will contact you with instructions about your participation. Note that only legitimate non-profit organizations are permitted, so we might require you to submit proof of your 501(c)3 status.

14. Can I sell my organization's merchandise or ask for donations at the festival?

Local ordinances do not allow the sale of any merchandise. Your organization cannot sell items, but you can request donations.

15. Do food vendors accept credit cards or digital payments, or should I bring cash?

All food vendors accept all types of payment! It's that easy to enjoy delicious food!

Logistics & Accessibility

16. Are restrooms and handwashing stations provided?

Yes! On the event day, attendees will have access to the park's restroom facilities, extra portable toilets, and handwashing stations.

17. Will there be seating areas or picnic spots?

The township will feature three large tents equipped with tables and chairs for your family to enjoy lunch and dinner. You are also welcome to use any of the park's green areas to eat.

18. Where can I park during the festival?

General parking will be available at the corner of Gordon Road and Sharon Road. The Robbinsville Department of Public Works will assist you in finding a parking spot, and the Robbinsville Police Department will help you cross Gordon Road to reach the event.



19. Is the festival accessible to people with disabilities?

Yes. Please see the image above for more.

20. Are pets allowed at the festival?

Yes, your furry family pets are welcome at the festival. However, according to park ordinances, please always keep them leashed and close to you to prevent incidents.

21. What should I bring (or not bring) with me?

Bring all your friends and your whole family! Leave at home anything that could harm people or damage park property. Meals on Wheels will have a beverage tent where you can purchase beer and wine, supporting their fundraiser. These beverages cannot be taken off the premises.

22. What happens if it rains—will the festival still be held?

The festival’s rain date is Sunday, June 14, at the same time, 2-9:30 p.m.

Community & Safety

18. How many people usually attend the festival?

We have confirmed an average attendance of between 5,000 and 7,000 people.

19. What safety and security measures will be in place?

Police officers will be stationed throughout the event. They are trained to ensure the safety and well-being of attendees. If there is an emergency, still call 911.

20. How can I report a lost item during the event?

Please visit the Police tent (until 5 p.m.) or the event information tent (open throughout the event hours) to report or retrieve a lost item.

21. Are drones allowed?

For everyone’s safety, drones are not allowed unless the Township of Robbinsville grants special written permission.

Media & Promotion

22. Can I take photos or videos at the festival?

You are free to take pictures or record videos for your personal use; however, please note that recordings in public spaces (streets, parks, sidewalks) are generally allowed. Recording is not permitted in bathrooms, dressing rooms, or other places where privacy is expected.

23. Will photos from the event be shared on social media or the township website?

Most likely! We're excited that many beautiful people will attend the festival, and we plan to take photos for memories and to post on our social media, possibly. If you prefer us to remove a picture of your family, please email us at rec@robbinsville.net.
