



F.A.Q.S. - Robbinsville Recreation League Grades 3-8

1. What's the duration of the program?

- a. The basketball season runs from November to March. Practices begin in November, and games begin in December.

2. How many practices and games are there per week?

- a. There is one practice per week.
- b. Games will vary by division

3. What are the timings & days of practice?

- a. Practice day/times are chosen by the coaches based on their availability. Practices are one-hour time slots Monday-Thursday from 6:30-9:30pm. Practices are held at Pond Road Middle School (PRMS) or Sharon Elementary School Yellow or Blue Gyms, depending on your child's team.

4. What are the timings & days of games?

- a. Games are played on Friday night or Saturday morning, depending on your child's division. Game times will vary and are sent out once teams are formed and scheduled.
 - i. Grades 7/8 will play Friday night at PRMS
 - ii. Grades 5/6 will play Saturday at PRMS
 - iii. Grades 3/4 will play Saturday at Sharon Elementary

5. Who coaches the players?

- a. Coaches are all parent volunteers. Please reach out to rec@robbinsville.net if you are interested in coaching!

6. When are evaluations?

- a. Wednesday, 10/14 OR Thursday, 10/15 at Pond Road Middle School gym. Your player only needs to attend one mandatory co-ed evaluation.
 - i. Grades 3/4 6pm

- ii. Grades 5/6 7pm
 - iii. Grades 7/8 8pm
- b. After evaluations, your child will be placed on a team, and you will be provided with all the information regarding specific times, days and locations. Please be sure to download the LeagueApps app to get up to date information and schedules. Communication will be directly with your coaches after practice starts.

7. What is the Refund Policy?

- a. Refunds Requests Before Evaluations: Registrants who wish to withdraw before the first day of evaluations may receive a full refund, provided that the Recreation Division is notified in writing at least five (5) business days before evaluations begin.
- b. Administrative fees paid at the time of registration are nonrefundable.
- c. Refunds Within 5 Days Prior to First Day of Evaluations:
If a withdrawal is requested within 5 days prior to the start of evaluations a credit will be issued to the account minus a 20% administrative service fee (not to exceed \$50).
- d. No Refunds After Drafts: No refunds or credits will be granted after team drafts have been completed unless given special permission from the Recreation Division.

8. What is the policy for Late Registration?

- a. A \$10 late fee is applied after the close of regular registration.
- b. No registrations are accepted after the final day of evaluations.

9. What is the Waitlist policy?

- a. The number of teams and players per team depends on the number of volunteer coaches.
- b. If Recreation cannot secure enough volunteer coaches for the number of players registered, the last players to register may be moved to a waitlist.
- c. In the event that a player cancels their registration, a player from the waitlist may be added to the team, provided this occurs prior to the start of the first game.

10. What is the replacement jersey policy?

- a. In the event that a player loses or misplaces their jersey and requires a replacement, they must contact **rec@robbinsville.net** to request a new jersey.
- b. Jerseys are based on size and number availability. Recreation is not required to provide a replacement.
- c. If a replacement is available, a **\$20 replacement fee** will apply and must be paid prior to the jersey being issued.

11. What is the Spectator Conduct Policy?

- a. Referees are responsible for maintaining safety and order at all games and may issue warnings for inappropriate behavior.
- b. Any individual receiving two warnings in one day will be directed by the referee to leave the game site.
- c. If an individual refuses to leave, law enforcement may be contacted.
- d. Anyone directed to leave on two separate occasions may be restricted from attending games for the rest of the season.
